

POOL RULES

- Use of the pool is restricted to RESIDENTS and/or houseguests entrusted with a key to the unit. Except by prior arrangement with the board (theboard@crescentvillagehoa.com), the number of guests will be limited to a maximum of four (4) per unit and Owner must be present at all times. Exceptions to this rule will be made strictly based on the frequency a unit owner has requested to have more than 4 Guests. Crescent Village wristbands have been issued by the Association and must be worn by all owners and their guests while using the pool facilities.
- Swimming pool hours during the season shall be **6:00 am – 10:00 pm.** Between the hours of 8pm and 10pm please keep the noise level to a minimum in consideration of nearby unit owners. Use of the pool and pool grounds during hours when it is closed is strictly prohibited
- Children under the age of 16, who have not passed a Red Cross certified swimmer course, shall not be allowed in the pool area unless accompanied by an adult.
- Proper swimwear must be worn in the pool.
- Food, glass containers or any types of glass are not allowed in the pool area.
- No person having a skin disease, or inflamed eyes, cough, cold, nasal or ear discharge, or any communicable disease (e.g. Psoriasis, Athletes Foot) shall use the pool.
- Spitting or blowing of the nose in the pool is prohibited.
- All persons shall shower before using the pool.
- Children not potty trained MUST wear rubber pants or similar protective clothing while in the pool.
- No pets are allowed in the pool or pool area.
- There shall be no rough housing, running, “cannon balls” or any activities detrimental to the safety or enjoyment of the pool by others. Any person(s) violating this rule will be asked to leave the pool. RESIDENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONDUCT OF THEIR CHILDREN AND GUESTS AT ALL TIMES.
- Individuals eating food or drinking beverages in the patio area will be responsible for proper disposal of any trash created. Food or alcoholic beverages are NOT permitted in the pool area. No smoking is allowed.
- No glass containers or glass of any kind is permitted in the pool area.
- Radios should be kept at a moderate volume.
- Pool furniture has been made available to enhance our residents’ enjoyment of the pool area. Please be sure to return it to the appropriate places along the concrete patio before leaving the pool area. The umbrella MUST be closed when not in use. (*An open umbrella can be very dangerous during high winds.*) In essence, if you opened the umbrella then you must close it prior to leaving the pool area. All others are asked to check to be sure that these tasks have been performed if they are the last ones leaving the pool area. Remember we do not employ a staff to do this.
